2008 Maybank Malaysian Open venue with a superb score of one-under 71. The four-handicapper could not have been happier and walked away in style as he picks up a Jaguar watch, a spot in the grand final, to be held at Awana Genting, and a four-day three-night golfing holiday in Melbourne,

In the Medal A category Yusaidi Yusof (6) shot nett 70 to claim the grand final berth on countback from Sallehuddin Hj Othman (9) and Dato Ng Lian Poh (3). An amazing round of nett 62 won 18-handicapper Barry

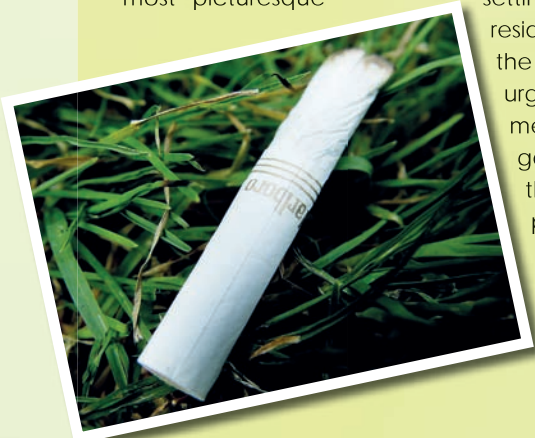

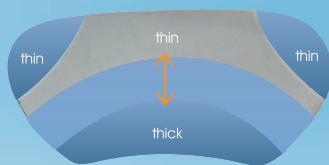

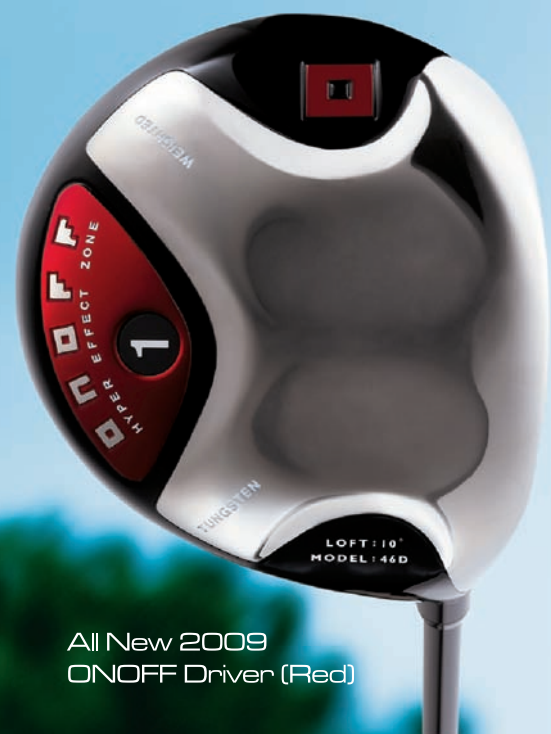

# KNOW THE RULES

## Rule 18 Ball at rest moved

During the recent inter-club game with Glenmarie, my flightmate touched and caused the ball to move when addressing the ball. She asked me if there was any penalty.

Referring to Decision 18/2 of the golf rules, "When addressing, the player accidentally caused the ball to oscillate but move back to its original position; has the ball "moved?" The answer is, "No, it hasn't moved."

Please note the difference in the above two situations; in the first case, the ball moved but in the second, the ball oscillated but moved back to its original position. Hence, there is a penalty for the first instance but not for the second.

A ball is deemed to have "moved" if it leaves its original position and comes to rest in any other place.

In general, when a player's ball is in play, and if:

- (i) The player, his partner or either of their caddies lifts or moves it, touches it purposely (except with a club in the act of addressing it) or causes it to move except as permitted by a Rule, or
- (ii) Equipment of the player or his partner causes the ball to move, the player incurs a penalty of one stroke.

If the ball is moved, it must be replaced unless the movement of the ball occurs after the player has begun the stroke or the backward movement of the club for the stroke and the stroke is made.

However, there is no penalty if a player **accidentally** causes his ball to move in the following circumstances:

- In searching for a ball in a hazard covered by loose impediments or sand, for a ball in an abnormal ground condition or for a ball



believed to be in water in a water hazard

- In repairing a hole plug or ball mark
- In measuring
- In lifting a ball under a Rule
- In placing or replacing a ball under a Rule
- In removing a loose impediment on the putting green
- In removing movable obstructions

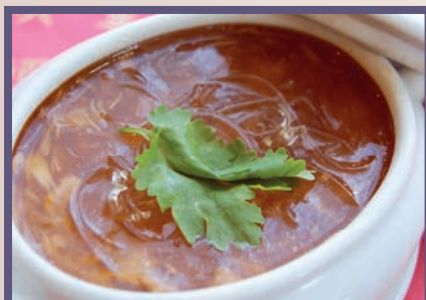

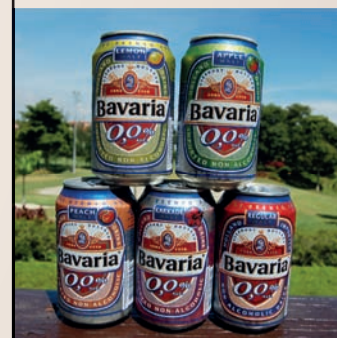
